Annual flowers live only one growing season

Annual plants must be set out or seeded every year. They are colorful, versatile and sturdy. Best of all, they are easy to grow, add instant color to containers or the landscape and bloom for most of the growing season.

Annuals give you the ability to experiment with color, texture, and height. If you're not happy with what you plant or where you plant, it will only last one growing season and can be changed next year.

Annuals are great for filling in small spaces, cover areas where spring bulbs are, and to fill planters, window boxes and hanging baskets.

Weekly removal of old flower heads is necessary for continuous bloom. Many annuals start to wear out by late summer and must be replaced or cut back for regrowth.

Caring for Annuals

- Select plants with usage in mind such as filler, accents, containers or masses of color.
- Plant according to sun exposure and expected height indicated on the plant tag.
- Feed your annuals with Nelson's Plant Food at planting and regularly to ensure a continuous bloom.
- Mulch to prevent evaporation and weeds.
- Remove spent blooms weekly, water regularly and do not let the soil dry out completely.
