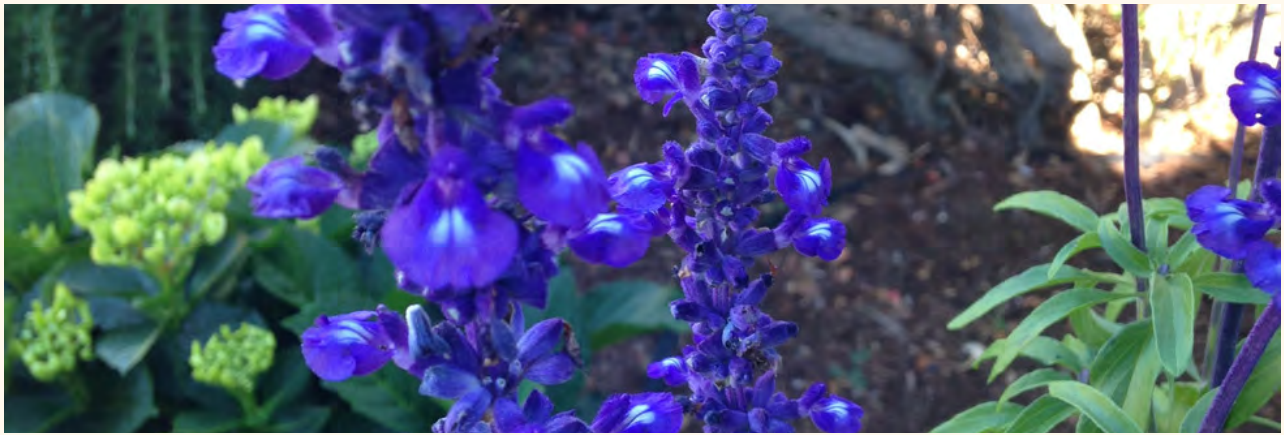

Perennials are plants that return year after year

Perennials provide beautiful accent color to your flowerbeds and containers. An advantage to planting perennials is they often come back more abundantly the next season and require minimal maintenance.

Perennials that are native to the area are also often more drought-tolerant and thrive when planted in the right place.

They make a great canvas to combine with bold colored annuals for a beautiful show of color in your garden.

With a little planning, plant flowering perennials based on height and bloom time so that your garden changes colors as one type of plant finishes blooming and another one begins.

SUNNY AREAS

Angelonia, Conflowers, Daylilies, Milkweed, Lantana, Rudbeckia, Rock Rose, Esperanza, Plumbago, Mexican Heather.

SHADE LOVING

Agapanthus, Begonia, Caladium, Coleus, Elephant Ear, Hydrangea, Ivy, Monkey Grass, Pentas, Salvia

Caring for Perennials

- Select plants with usage in mind such as edging, accents, evergreens or masses of color.
- Plant according to sun exposure and expected height indicated on the plant tag.
- Feed your perennials with Nelson's Plant Food at planting, after bloom and in early Spring.
- Remove spent blooms, mulch to conserve water and protect the plant from extreme conditions.
